



Make a Lobster door guard

You will need:

- 1 pre-cut lobster body
- 2 pre-cut large lobster claws
- 2 pre-cut small lobster claws
- 1 pre-cut card seaweed
- 4 split pins
- 1 eraser
- 1 sharp pencil
- 2 pipe cleaners
- 2 eye stickers
- Coloured pens

Instructions

Make sure the little circles in the claws and lobster body are popped out to make holes

Attach the larger claws to the lobster's body using 1 split pin per claw

lobster's body using 1 split pin per claw Now attach the smaller claws to the lobster's large claws using 1 split pin per claw

Make 4 holes in the top of the lobster's head by pushing the sharp pencil through the card into the eraser

Now take one pipe cleaner and push it through the front of one hole, bend it around and return it through the second hole across from it (this will help to create a loop you can use to hang your lobster up)


Now push the second pipe cleaner through one of the remaining holes so that it looks like the picture below

On one of your lobster's claws glue the leaf shape (you can write you message on here)

Decorate your lobster with eyes and coloured pens

TOP FACT!

Lobsters can "throw a claw", meaning they can release a claw from their body and grow a new one!
