

Makea Paper plate whale

You will need:

- 1 paper plate
- Blue coloured pencils
- 1 eye sticker, Blue card
- 1 black pen
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 glue stick

Instructions

Colour your whole paper plate in blue

Using your scissors cut about a quarter of the plate off

On the blue card draw and cut out 2 shapes, 1 for the water from the whale's head and 1 for his tail

Stick the water onto the top of your whale's head

Now stick your tail shape onto your whale's body, then glue the smaller piece of your paper plate to the end of his tail to make his fluke

Add an eye sticker and draw a mouth

Congratulations! You have made your very own whale!

Minke whales can hold their breath for up to 20-25 minutes! This means they can dive for long periods of time.
